


A 3D Printed LEGO Technic Compatible mount for a 3AAA Battery Holder.

## Step 2 — Tips & Tricks





 The battery pack sits inside the holder loosely. If you want a more secure fit you can add some tape to hold the battery pack in place.

New Every 3D printer is a little different! If your part doesn't fit properly here are a few things to try.

- Part too tight? Try sanding it or cutting away some material with a knife.
- Part too loose? Add some tape to act as a shim.
- You can also try printing it at slightly more or less than 100% scale.
